

NOTICE OF RATE INCREASE

Groome Transportation of Southern Colorado, LLC, dba Groome Transportation filed Passenger Tariff, Colorado PUC No. 1 with the Colorado Public Utilities Commission on November 6, 2018.

Groome Transportation of Southern Colorado, LLC, dba Groome Transportation is authorized by Common Carrier Certificate No. 55272 to provide scheduled passenger service between the Colorado Springs Municipal Airport and other points in Colorado Springs, on the one hand, and Denver International Airport (DIA), on the other hand; and call-and-demand shuttle service between all points within a 50-mile radius of the intersection of U. S. Highway 24 and Colorado Highway 67 in Woodland Park.

Groome Transportation of Southern Colorado, LLC, dba Groome Transportation, in this tariff filing, is proposing to increase the fares and rates for the scheduled service and the call-and-demand shuttle service.

The call-and-demand shuttle service rates being increased are:

In addition, changes are being made to the reservation and cancellation policy as follows:

A passenger must cancel or change a reservation by 11:59pm the day before your travel date. **No refunds will be issued.** If a passenger needs to cancel, the passenger will be issued a credit for use on future travel within the next year. The travel credit is valid for one year from its issue date (the date of the original cancellation). Travel must be rebooked by the expiration date (one year from its issue date). The travel does not need to occur by the expiration date.

Credit will not be issued if cancelling after 11:59pm the day before the travel date. Same-day reservations are not eligible for credit if cancelled

If a passenger has requested taxi service and is not at the agreed upon pick-up location at the agreed upon pick-up/departure time, no refund will be issued. (C)

The proposed effective date of the increased fares is November 3, 2021, unless the Colorado Public Utilities Commission suspends the effective date of the proposed changes.

Objections to the proposed tariff changes must be made in writing and filed with the Colorado Public Utilities Commission, 1560 Broadway, Denver, CO 80202, at least 10 days before the proposed effective date of November 3, 2021. If the Commission sets the matter for hearing, the filing of a written objection will not by itself allow a person to participate in the hearing. To participate in the hearing, a party must also file a written intervention and receive approval of the Commission to intervene. Requests to intervene as a party must comply with Commission rules.
